Studio Rules and Regulations

<u>Communications</u> – All of our important information is sent via email. Please be sure to check your email on a regular basis to ensure you are up-to-date on all announcements. All credit card payments will email you a receipt, as well. You can also download our MLSD App for your phone to receive push notification reminders ⁽³⁾ If you find that you are not receiving our emails, please let us know. Be sure to check your SPAM folder!

Attendance – Students are expected to be in attendance for all classes. They will receive a student ID tag to use to scan in at the computer on the front desk. They should attach the ID tag to their dance bag so they don't lose it. There is a \$5 replacement fee if the tag is lost. Attendance is reviewed by the teachers. Please notify the studio when absences are necessary. Make-up classes are available in some cases, by scheduling private lessons with your instructor. There will be no refunds or pro-rating of tuition for missed classes.

<u>Class Viewing</u> – Parents and guests are invited to watch the last 5-10 minutes of classes on Watch Weeks. Watch Weeks are usually the first full week of each month. They are noted on the studio calendar on our website as well as in the important dates listed in this packet. Students generally pay much better attention without the distraction of spectators in the room, but we have arranged regular Watch Weeks for you to see how your child is doing in class

Lost and Found – Items left at the studio are kept for a limited time only. Please check the lost and found periodically; all unclaimed items are donated to local charities at the end of each month.

<u>Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up</u> – Please be prompt in dropping off and picking up of your child. For your child's safety, we ask that you come in with any student under the age of 10. The studio closes at 9:15pm each evening. We ask that you respect the needs of our employees by being on time. In the event of an emergency, please call the studio.

No Food or Drink Permitted in Classrooms – All food and drink must remain in the lobby, except for water in water bottles.

Enrollment Changes/Drops – If your child chooses to change a class, it must be put in writing in our "Change Class Form" and returned to MLSD. Should your child choose to drop a class, you must fill out a "Drop Class Form" and return it to MLSD at least one week prior to the next month otherwise you will still owe for the following month. If you choose to withdraw from all classes, you will be responsible for all charges applied to the account prior to the date the "Drop Class Form" is returned to MLSD. This includes, but is not limited to, late fees, finance charges, tuition, entry fees, costume balances, etc.

<u>Class Cancellations/Snow Days</u> - We cannot help the weather when snow is concerned. Normally, we will follow Peoria county schools, but there are instances when it snows in the morning and roads are fine later or vice versa. We will email out our closing information and notify the local news stations as soon as we can reasonably make a determination of what is in the best interest of our staff, our students, and the parents. Since our rent and bills are not discounted due to snow, we will be unable to credit anyone back for any snow days that are missed. If a class misses more than one week due to snow, we will schedule a weekend makeup lesson. We generally stay open unless we don't have enough staff available to keep our classes running. However, we always urge you to use your discretion, and only venture out in bad weather if you feel comfortable doing so. We understand if you decide to miss class due to poor weather, even if we choose to stay open.

Lobby Rules – No Tap Shoes on the lobby/hallway wooden floor. No students allowed in the dance rooms without a teacher unless special permission is given by Miss Laura. Dance Bags should be placed in the cubbies to keep the lobby as tidy as possible. Please pick up after yourself to help keep the studio clean, including cleaning out your cubbie when you leave © Please don't let your children play in/block the hallway or closets...the noise carries into the dance rooms and is distracting. Children and parents should remain in the lobby until called back for class by the instructor or called back by to watch on Watch Weeks.

Creative movement is a joyful way for children to explore movement through music, develop physical skills, channel energy, stimulate imagination and promote creativity.

This class is for 2-3 year olds who aren't quite ready for a structured dance class or a recital performance. It is 30-minutes long, once a week. The goal is to learn to move to different types of music, to express the face and body to match that music, as well as body awareness, how to share space with others, and learning how to follow orders from the dance teacher.

Classroom Attire

Being a dancer means dressing the part. We ask that all students dress appropriately for all classes each week.

Recreational Classes:

<u>Creative Movement</u> – White or pink tights, any leotard. Skirts and booty shorts are ok to wear over leotard. Full Sole Ballet Slippers.

Caterpillar – White or pink tights, any leotard. Skirts and booty shorts are ok to wear over leotard. Pink Full Sole Leather Ballet Slippers & Black Patent Leather Tap Shoes. *Recommend buying tap shoes with elastic or button closure options to speed up shoe changes in class ©

Butterfly & Level 1 Jazz/Tap Combo Classes – Any form-fitting active wear (no loose t-shirts or denim). Tan Slip-On Jazz Shoes (Capezio or Bloch) and Black Patent Leather Tap Shoes. *Recommend buying tap shoes with elastic or button closure options to speed up shoe changes in class ©

Ballet Classes – Any solid color leotard and white or pink tights. Pink ballet shoes (leather full sole for Level I, canvas split sole for Level II & up). Hair pulled back away from face, preferably in a bun. Pre-Pointe is available for students ages 10 & up. Pointe available with teacher approval only.

<u>Acrobat Classes</u> – Any leotard, tight fitting tops and booty shorts. Any color jazz shoes. Hair should be pulled back out of the face. Note: Loose fitting closing makes it difficult to spot tumbling.

<u>Hip-Hop Classes</u> – Loose fitting clothing such as sweat pants, harem pants, t-shirts and tank tops. Jazz shoes or tennis shoes (not worn outside) are ok to wear in class. Actual shoes for the recital will be selected once the costume is selected. Hair pulled back out of the face.

Lyrical/Contemporary Classes – Any form-fitting active wear. Nude spinner shoes or foot undeez are acceptable to wear in class. Actual shoes for the recital will be selected once the costume is selected. Hair pulled back out of the face.

Tap Classes (Level II & Up) – Any form-fitting active wear. Tan Mary-Jane Style Tap Shoes (Capezio or Bloch). Hair pulled back out of the face.

<u>Jazz Classes (All Levels)</u> – Any form-fitting active wear. Tan Slip-On Jazz Shoes (Capezio or Bloch). Hair pulled back out of the face.



Competition Classes:

Ballet – Pink Canvas Ballet Shoes (Split Sole). Solid leotard, pink tights. Hair in bun.

Leaps/Turns – Solid leotard, tights, hair in bun, any shoes,

Tap - Black Oxford Tie Tap Shoes (Bloch or Capezio)

Jazz/Acrobats & Production – Tan Show Stopper Jazz by Capezio (Color may change once costumes are selected).
